MILITARY AIRCRAFT CRASHED IN UP PARK CAMP

At approximately 1230 hrs on 01 July 2009 a Bell 412 EP military aircraft (helicopter) which was carrying out a training mission crashed in Up Park Camp. The aircraft had onboard the aircraft captain, his co-pilot and a crew member, no civilians were on board.

The aircraft experienced difficulties and subsequently crashed.

All of the crew members were taken to the University Hospital of the West Indies where they have been admitted in stable condition.

A detailed investigation is currently being conducted.
